PUBLIC NOTICE OF WORK

To: Residents & Businesses

Re: Sanitary Sewer Smoke Testing in the Plank Road Drainage Area

Please be advised that sanitary sewer smoke testing in the Plank Road drainage area (1249 Plank Road to Churchill Line, Gladwish Drive, Duff Drive, Bill Boulevard, Atkin Avenue, and Prescott Drive) has been scheduled to start on **Monday, September 24, 2018 at 8:00 am.**

Wessuc (wessuc.com) will be conducting the smoke testing work on behalf of the City of Sarnia. This testing is done periodically in order to locate sources of sewer odors, leaks, breaks, and cross-connections in sewer lines.

The type of smoke used is non-toxic, white to grey in colour and may have a slight odor. It is harmless to plants, animals, and humans. If smoke gets into your home or business, please ventilate the building promptly.

On the outside of your house or business, or your neighbours', you may notice smoke coming from the following:

- Sewer vents;
- Gutters and downspouts;
- Out of the ground along sewer lines.

On the inside of your house or business, smoke or its odor may come out of the plumbing fixtures. This is an indication that dangerous gases and unpleasant odors from the sanitary sewers may enter the building. This should NOT happen if your plumbing is in good working order. You can minimize the chances of this happening by running sufficient amounts of water into sinks, tubs, showers and floor drains in order to fill up sewer traps with water.

Identifying, locating, and correcting the source of smoke entering your house or building is urgently advised. The correction of any defects in pipe and sewer lines on private property is the property owner's responsibility.

If you detect smoke in your house or building and are uncertain as to what the cause may be, please call the City of Sarnia Public Works Department at 519-344-1932.

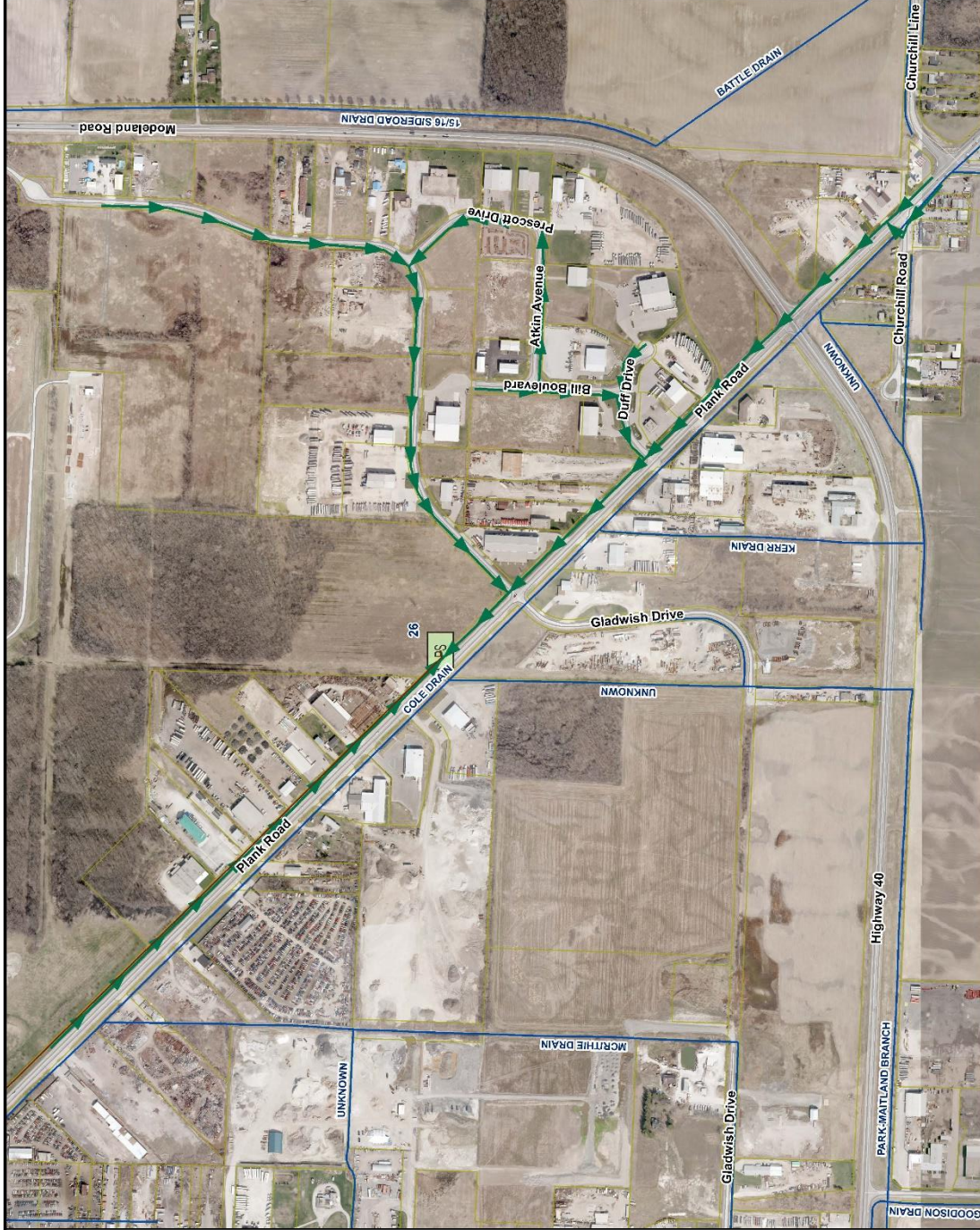
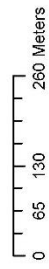
- Map of the Plank Road Sanitary Sewer Drainage Area
